The selected works indicate The One Minutes Collection's international scope and diversity. Joris Nouwens is a Dutch visual artist and media producer. Thierry Mandon lives in France and works with video, photography, performance and installation. Filmmaker, screenwriter and photographer Fleur Boonman works in Belgium, Asia and LA. Donna Verheijden is an Arnhem-based graphic designer and videographer. Visual artist Maartje Jaquet from Amsterdam travels, wanders, sees and finds little treasures. Tessa Garland is a London-based artist and curator who makes experimental films. French contemporary artists and brothers Florian and Michael Quistrebert combine video and painting. The work of Amsterdam-based media artists Persijn Broersen and Margit Lukács consists of layered projections, digital animations and spatial installations. Slias Fong is a Hong Kong contemporary artist who works with photography and video. And Belgian professor emeritus of computer science, Jan Paredaens uses software to generate abstract videos.
