


How to search The One Minutes Collection?

The One Minutes Collection consists of over 15,000 video works by artists from more than 120 countries. The collection is preserved by The Netherlands Institute for Sound and Vision, which manages audio-visual heritage. 
SEARCH

You can search through the collection by entering one or more keywords in the search bar. The most recent entries appear in top of the list. Separate words in the search (i.e. title) will generate results with one or more of these words.

Via the three dots it is possible to search on a Date range and/or different Metadata fields.

Search in the Metadata Field => Title for The One Minutes



Now you can search on names, titles, tags etc.

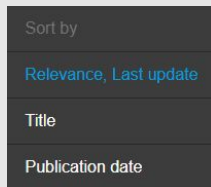

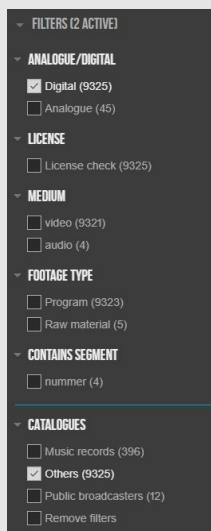
The One Minutes

Search results:

can be sorted by Relevance, Last update / Title / Publication date



can be filtered by Filter options on the left



Important: The One Minutes are part of the Catalogue: Others

Details page:

By clicking on a search result the Details page is presented

On the Details page it is possible to view and listen to The One Minute by clicking on the play button within the poster frame



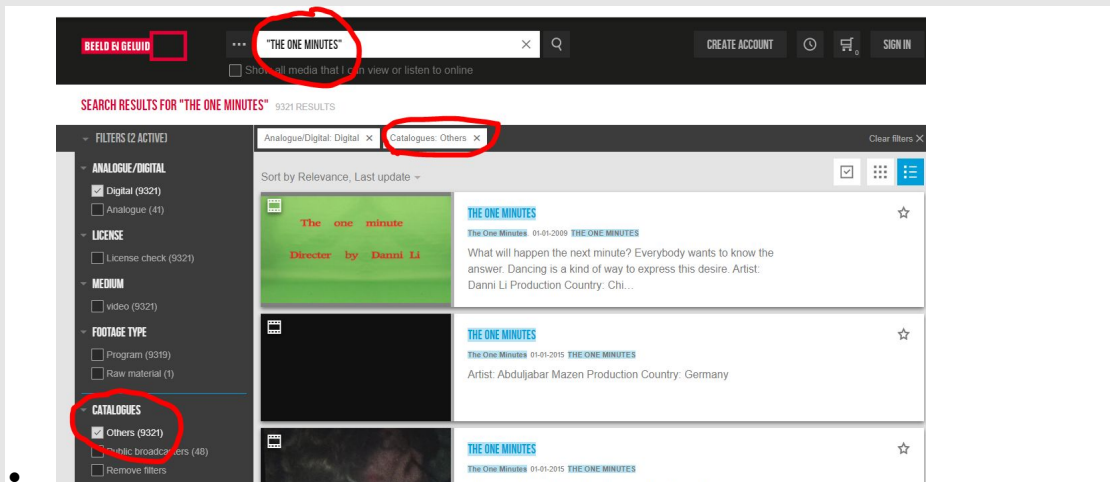

Some important tips for searching The One Minutes

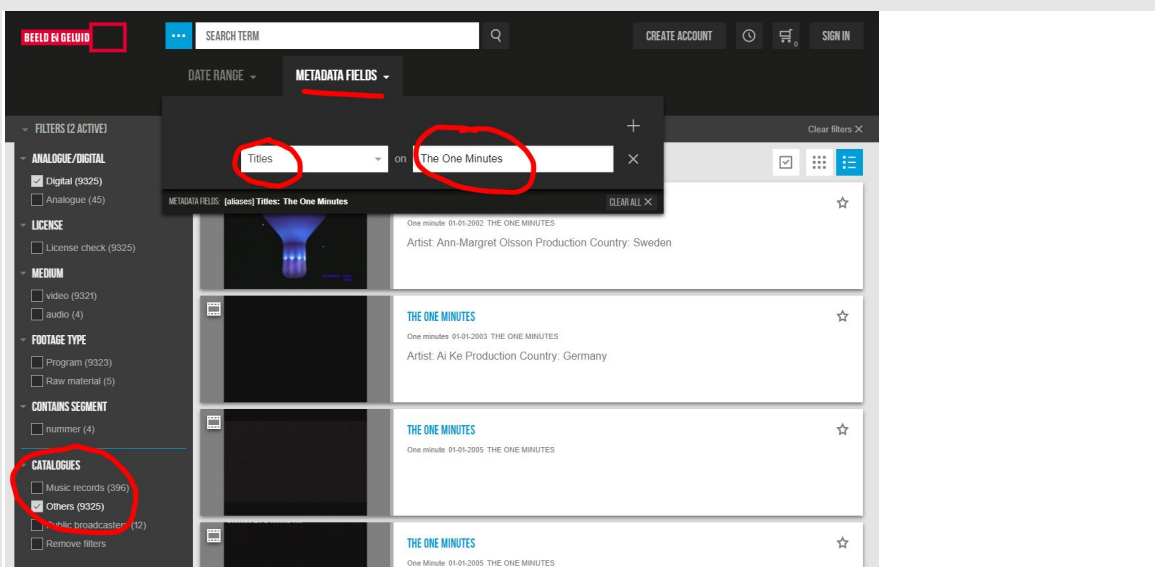
The One Minutes, option 1:

- Free text search “The One Minutes”
- The quotation marks mean: find words between quotation marks in that specific order
- Combine the above with Filter on Catalogues Other



The One Minutes, option 2:

- Search via the three dots in the Metadata Field => Title for The One Minutes Combine the above with Filter on Catalogues Other
- Combine the above with Filter on Catalogues Other

The One Minutes

The One Minutes, extra options:

- Within The One Minutes it is possible to search Free text on available metadata, like Names, Titles, Tags, Production country etc.



- It is also possible to combine different options, in the example below the search is as follows:
 - Metadata field Title should contain The One Minutes
 - AND
 - Metadata field Summary should contain the word "weather"
