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One Minute repetitions, translations and bifurcated histories premiere at Kinemastik

Kinemastik and The One Minutes present 'Forked Tongue' curated by Madison Bycroft.

The Forked Tongue includes ten one minute videos that move in two directions, are ambivalent, layered, and in between. Repetitions, translations, and bifurcated histories proliferate, as do restless characters performing multiple gestures, unanchored, and never still. These works evade a single sense. Instead of containing things within specified boundaries or capacities a space opens for multiplicity and ambiguity.

The selected videos were sent in from Australia, France, Netherlands, Portugal, Turkey and United Kingdom and are a response to Bycroft's open call on the topic of doublespeak, duplicity and ambivalence.

'Forked Tongue' will premiere at the 17th Kinemastik International Short Film Festival taking place in Malta 14-21 November 2021. The online premiere is hosted by Het Nieuwe Instituut on Thursday 2 December at 8pm CEST.

Bycroft is a graduate from the University of South Australia (2013), and the MFA program at the Piet Zwart Institute in Rotterdam (2016). Working with video, sculpture and performance, Madison Bycroft's current interests extend into forms of reading and writing, expression and refusal. The politics of illegibility and legibility are explored through language and material, asking how 'sense' is framed by historical contexts, biases, and structures of power.
