

**citizenM Miami Brickell Extends The One Minutes Public Video Installation**

citizenM, known for integrating art into its properties, has extended its art partnership with The One Minutes at its Miami Brickell location. The video installation in the hotel elevators will remain in place for an additional three years, until 2028. This exhibition transforms everyday transit spaces into dynamic cultural experiences, offering both hotel guests and the public unexpected moments of artistic discovery through bite-sized, one-minute video works. countries. The One Minutes collaborates with partners in innovative ways to exhibit these works, redefining how art is experienced.
