citizenM continues its art partnership with The One Minutes, extending the video installation in the elevators of its Paris Champs-Élysées location for another three years. This exhibition transforms transit spaces into dynamic cultural experiences, using the one-minute format to create bite-sized artistic encounters. The selected works for this installation include:
